## **Breech Clout Instructions**

(Made from Scratch – No Kit Used)

Typically, the front Breech cloth should run the width of a person from hip bone to hip bone and it should be pants height on the waist to mid thigh.

The easiest way to prepare the breech cloth is to take those measurements specific to the individual person and add 3.5 inches in height. This 3.5 inches can then be flipped over and stitched to create a sleeve which any standard belt will run through.

The back breech cloth should be the same width as the front and should be at least as long as the front. Most will make the back at least knee length and some will even come within an inch of touching the ground.

The breech cloth can be decorated elaborately with designs made of ribbon, felt, leather, or beads, or it can be left plain and undecorated depending upon style and desire.
